GFA RULES OF PLAY U-10

1. **2 – 20 minute halves; 5-minute halftime. (1) referee for the match.**
2. FIFA rules except as noted; ball size 4.
3. **Unlimited substitutes**
4. Tri-Game set-up. A v B, B v C, and A v C. Each team plays each other (1) twenty (20) minute half.
5. Players must play for one team only.
6. **No offsides will be called; pass back to goalie will be allowed.**
7. Coaches must stay in one yard from the side-line; no coaches on the end lines or opposite side of field. Spectators must be at least 5 yards from the sidelines.
8. Substitutes must enter at half-line after player has cleared the field at half-line and only with permission from the referee.
9. Field size: 30 yards by 50 yards..
10. Minimum of 5 players to start a game; **7 players per side. Player must play for one team only.**
11. **NO PENALTY KICKS.** All fouls shall be an indirect free kick; opposing players to be at least 8 yards from the ball. Players get 2 chances on throw-ins.
12. Roster shall be limited to 20 players and to the extent possible, all players must play at least half a game.
13. Teams listed first are the Home Teams and will be responsible for supplying the game balls
14. Home teams will provide alternate color shirts or vest if necessary.
15. Rained out games will not be rescheduled
16. Remember this is a non-competitive league. The concept is to develop skills and build self-esteem and good sportsmanship. League standing will not to be recorded.
17. For the Good of the Game, always observe the FIFA canons of Fair Play.

7. show respect for the game officials by not criticizing them or undermining their authority in the eyes of our players
8. display good sportsmanship as a positive example for my player
9. represent not only my player, but also the team, our club, the league, and the game of soccer and will conduct myself accordingly.
10. do the greater good

SCHEDULE and GAME RULES

Failure to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines, the following steps will be taken by the GFA Youth Field Official, Gian Tenorio.

1. Verbal warning
2. Written warning
3. Game suspension with written documentation of incident kept on file by organizations involved
4. Game forfeit
5. Parental season suspension
6. Should the spectator be a youth member of GFA, player card may be seized.
